

## **Publication protocol concerning GWA publications referring to combined NESDA and NTR data**

1. If a publication refers to NESDA respondents as well as NTR respondents, the team of authors will consist of both NESDA and NTR researchers. Subjects will be put forward by researchers and revised by the NESDA/NTR supervision team\*. Aimed is for a balance in authors from NESDA and NTR.

If the first author is from NESDA, the last author will be from NTR, and vice versa. The first and the last author should both be involved with the analysis and design of the publication in an early stage.

2. When 9 months after availability of all needed data there has been no activity on a proposed publication, new agreements can be made about the subject.

3. If there is a scientific disagreement about the interpretation of results and/or analysis, the NESDA/NTR supervision team decides.

4. Patrick Sullivan will have the opportunity to join GWA-publications.

5. GWA analysis based on NESDA and NTR will be checked for adequacy by a central "GWA analysis team". This analysis team will consist of analysts from NESDA and NTR.

6. Publications that present GWA analysis based on NESDA and NTR data, will have to be approved by the NESDA/NTR supervision team before submission. The team will check if NESDA and NTR are described correctly and if the right acknowledgements are given.
